Within the mastery-based learning model, students receive additional instruction and practice on identified skills before progressing to subsequent learning standards.
IXL	Grades 7-8, Fort Wayne Campus	Provides individualized practice in English language arts and mathematics. IXL is delivered during designated intervention and instructional-support periods to address skill gaps identified through diagnostic, assessment, and classroom data.
